ONE LESS THING TO WORRY ABOUT.

For high-performance water heating, propane tankless units have all of the benefits with none of the trade-offs of heat pump water heaters.

Endless hot water delivery

Tankless water heaters run continuously, on-demand, and they have triple the hot water flow rate of heat pump water heaters. And they're not limited by storage capacity, so homeowners never have to run out of water.

Save space

Tankless units save floor space and are flexible enough to be installed indoors or outdoors. But heat pump water heaters may not even be an option in many homes due to their size, space, and temperature requirements. Plus, they cost at least 34 percent more than tankless units to install in new homes and 18 percent more in remodels.

Cheaper to own

Tankless water heaters last longer — about 20 years, compared with 15 years for a heat pump water heater. So while both technologies offer high-efficiency water heating, the annual cost of ownership for heat pump water heaters is about 18 percent higher in new homes and 13 percent higher in remodels.
